WELCOME:

PEAK Performance Basketball, a division of PEAK Performance Sports & Development Foundation, Inc., welcomes you to our 2024 tryout sessions! We are honored to have your student-athlete join us for our 19th year of serving and shaping young girls through basketball.

PEAK Performance Sports and Development Foundation, Inc., a Georgia 501 (c) 3 non-profit Corporation, founded in 2005, has a cause of "Developing Little Girls Into Leading Women" through our programming that emphasizes high standards for academic, athletic and social development of girls in grades 2 - 11.

Our "WHY"

At **PEAK**, we **BELIEVE** in and are dedicated to, the development of the "Total Child." We **BELIEVE** that through our programming we can positively impact the trajectory of the future and protect the potential of every girl that we serve. We utilize sports to help develop "Little Girls into Leading Women." At **PEAK**, we are committed to taking girls "as they are," creating an environment that will inspire and motivate them to achieve higher levels of performance in the classroom and in athletics, while building self-esteem and a positive self-image. **PEAK** seeks to build positive, highly motivated and educated young women who will be successful in life "when the ball stops bouncing."

OUR PLAYER SELECTION PROCESS

The PEAK coaching staff will evaluate your players' fundamental basketball skills, leadership attributes and attitude during the tryout sessions. We strongly suggest that you attend more than one tryout session, which will allow our staff to adequately evaluate the players' skill level and potential. PEAK may not offer every grade level Team in every area. Team development is based on tryout numbers by grade and by area. (ie. We may have a 6th Grade Team in North GA, but not in North Fulton, or we may combine players from different area, but they will practice in their home area.) Also, we may combine some age groups in an area (ie. 6th/7th) on the same Team, based on skill level. Our goal is to place our girls in the best position to have an enjoyable and successful season. **The PEAK Team Roster will consist of a maximum of 10 players.**

As the coaches reach a decision on the placement of a player, a PEAK OFFER LETTER will be emailed to you, with information on your Team placement and Coach. Upon receipt of your offer, you will be given **48 hours to accept or decline the PEAK offer. All offer letters will be extended by January 30th, at 8:00PM.**

2024 PEAK TEAM HUBS

At PEAK, we have a fundamental philosophy to bring our programming to various communities around the state of Georgia to make it easier for families to participate in our programming. This allows us to minimize drive time to practice sessions. In 2024, we offer Local Teams in the following Hub Areas, based on tryout participation:

- **Johns Creek GA**
- **North Georgia – Dawsonville GA**
- **South Georgia – Tifton GA**

2024 PEAK 8th Grade National Team

Between the Classes of 2011 - 2024, PEAK BASKETBALL has signed 162 Girls into the NCAA. Many of these outstanding student-athletes developed in our Middle School Program. As the NCAA Recruiting Player Identification Process started earlier, in 2024 we will continue to offer Middle School National Teams for advanced level 7th & 8th Grade Players. Middle School National Teams will mirror our High School National Team, where we identify our 10 most talented players (per Team) to participate against national level competition at NCAA Certified Events across the Southeast Region of the United States. 8th grade National Teams are designed for committed, advanced level players who have a desire to play basketball at the College Level. **The National Team players will practice mostly in their Regional Hubs with the local PEAK**

Teams but will periodically practice together in preparation for national Tournaments. Along with their local schedule, the National Teams will participate in 4 NCAA Certified Events, where they will travel. The National Team season will end in July.

PEAK PRACTICE:

PEAK Teams will practice two times per week (1.5 hours per session) beginning in February. Listed below are our contracted practice facilities:

- Atlanta, Alpharetta & Johns Creek Area – Mt. Pisgah Christian School
- North Georgia – Dawson County High School
- South Georgia – Tiftarea Academy

TOURNAMENTS:

During the months of February – June, PEAK Local Teams will participate in 2-3 Tournaments per month. The PEAK Teams will participate in locally sponsored metro-Atlanta Events and 2 out of State Events.

COACHING:

The PEAK Performance Basketball Coaching Staff is committed to creating a positive learning and competitive environment, thus enabling your young athlete to have a rewarding basketball experience. To that end, our coaches bring years of coaching and/or high school/college playing experience. They all will have passed background checks prior to the start of the season. Our goal is to prepare every player for High School Basketball and possibly the opportunity to play at the College level. PEAK Coaches will adhere to our five **CORE VALUES: MOTIVATE, INSPIRE, TEACH, LEAD and EMPOWER.**

2024 ANNUAL PROGRAM FEES:

The 2024 PEAK Annual Program Fee provides your youth player a **Membership at PEAK** for the calendar year of 2024. PEAK believes in making it EASY for parents to understand the financial obligations as well as what you are getting for your Annual Program Fee. We want to provide you and your child with the best experience possible at a reasonable cost. The operations of PEAK Basketball require a sizeable investment due to cost of uniforms, facilities, equipment, administrative cost, tournament cost, travel cost, coaches' stipends etc. Please make sure that you are prepared to make the financial and time commitment necessary to participate in the 2024 PEAK Program. Please be aware that every youth sports organization will present the finances differently. At PEAK we publish a list of exactly what is included in your Program Fees.

2024 LOCAL TEAM PROGRAM FEES:

PEAK 6th - 8th Grade Teams: \$825.00

2024 NATIONAL TEAM PROGRAM FEES:

All player travel expenses (transportation, meals, and lodging) are the responsibility of the parents.

NOTE:

2024 Annual Program Fees are due and payable on or before January 30th, 2024.

You may pay your Program Fees by cash, check, online via the PEAK website or cashapp (\$bprice1203).

PAYMENT PLAN:

If a payment plan is required, you will be able make an initial payment of \$400.00 on or before January 30th and the balance will be spread over 2 additional installments, payable in full by April 30, 2024. Your first installment payment may be payable by cash, check, online via the PEAK website or cashapp. Your remaining two installments will be billed via email. Player uniforms will not be distributed until the initial payment has been received.

Failure to uphold your financial obligation could cause your player to be removed from the program.

PEAK has a no refund policy once the player has been registered on a team with the following being the ONLY exception: the player becomes injured to the point that they cannot play for the remainder of the season and presents a doctor's note to the club. In this case, the refund will be prorated for the remaining portion of the season that the player cannot attend.

2024 PEAK SKILLS ACADEMY

No Player Left Behind

The PEAK Skills Academy is designed for two types of players:

- Girls who may have gotten cut from a school, AAU or YBOA Team because their skills and experience was not on the level with other players.
- Girls who play multiple sports that do not have the time to commit fully to a basketball travel Team, but they want to stay sharp and improve their skills for the next school season.
- At PEAK, if girls don't make one of the 6th through 8th Grade Teams, they are automatically invited to enroll into the **PEAK Basketball Skills Academy, or you can simply enroll in PEAK Skills Academy without going through a tryout process.**

2024 PEAK SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

PEAK will offer two opportunities to offset the cost of the Annual Program Fee for players in 2024.

HOPE FOR HOOPS Student-Athlete Scholarship Award Program:

The HOPE FOR HOOPS Student-Athlete Scholarship Award is an inspiration of Kaitlyn Dinkins, (PEAK Class of 2011, Harvard Class of 2015) an accomplished student and talented athlete. Her goal was to establish and fund a scholarship program which will provide young, female basketball players with the necessary financial support to help them follow their dreams in becoming the best student-athlete possible. Today's student-athlete faces many challenges on and off the court. Intensive training, hectic team travel schedules and demanding academic course work are requirements for student-athletes aspiring to compete at the highest levels possible.

In 2024 The **HOPE FOR HOOPS** Student-Athlete Scholarship Award will be granted to the most qualified individuals who demonstrate academic, civic, and athletic accomplishments. Awards will be made in the amount of up to **\$250.00 each**. There will be a minimum of four awards granted annually to qualified applicants. Award applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements to be considered for this scholarship:

- Must be a United States citizen
- Must be between the ages of 11 and 17 years of age and enrolled in an accredited institution
- Must have a 3.0 GPA ("B") or higher (a full transcript may be requested)
- Must be a current member of the PEAK Program
- 4 recommendations: 2 teacher/administrator recommendations, 1 coach recommendation, 1 community/civic or guidance counselor recommendation with application
- A written, five-hundred-word essay. Essay should be autobiographical, addressing the student-athlete's goals, accomplishments as well as any financial needs

Completed applications must be received no later than March 1st, 2024. Limit one scholarship award per applicant per year. 2024 HOPE FOR HOOPS Awards will be made by March 31, 2024. You must pay your initial deposit of \$400.00. Should you be awarded the \$250.00 HOPE for HOOPS Scholarship, your remaining balance will be reduced by \$250.00. PEAK STUDENT-ATHLETE SUPPORT FUND

Any player may raise their Annual Program Fees through our Student-Athlete Support Fund. PEAK Performance is a Georgia 501 (c) 3 non-profit corporation, and any donations that players solicit from friends or family, are tax-deductible and will be 100% applied to your 2024 Program Fees. PEAK will provide the solicitation letter.

LIFE ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM:

A critical success factor for PEAK Performance is to develop PEAK Girls, who will have the core skills to be successful in life "When The Ball Stops Bouncing." In 2024, we will continue to conduct periodic Life Skills, Leadership, Character, and Academic Development Sessions, open to all PEAK players, during the year. We place as much value on attendance at these personal development sessions as we do basketball practice.

Our PEAK Life Achievement Program goal will be achieved by providing age-appropriate content to PEAK Girls, through a variety of educational forums. These forums extend the on-court teachings and will include seminars and workshops leveraging relevant and timely material. Guest speakers, community leaders and role models will share important concepts while inspiring and motivating PEAK girls.

PEAK Basketball & Leadership Retreat

The PEAK Basketball & Leadership Retreat it is designed to expose PEAK Girls to corporate leaders, entrepreneurs and motivational speakers that will inspire them to recognize and reach their inner greatness and become “Go-Getters and Game Changers.” Our mission at PEAK is to prepare our girls to be successful in life “when the ball stops bouncing.” The weekend is designed to provide the girls with some high intensity basketball workouts as they prepare for High School Basketball.

We are planning to host our 2024 Leadership Retreat in June, dates to be determined. Our Leadership Retreat will be held at Berry College.

How can Parents get involved in PEAK:

Many ways! PEAK needs your Wealth, Wisdom and/or your Work! We welcome support of every kind at PEAK. As a Georgia non-profit Corporation, we have an Annual PEAK Momentum Fund, which enables us to fund our Life Achievement Programs, our Student-Athlete Support Fund and our Leadership Retreat. Team videographer & photographer – We love to teach the game of basketball by watching film. It is very helpful when we have a parent volunteer who films the games and uploads the film to our recruiting site. Also, capturing photos of the Team on and off the court is very vital to our branding and marketing efforts.
